Sub:- Two (2) Days Training of Khadim-ul-Hujjaj Programme for Haj - 2022.

In continuation to this office Circular No.9 (Ref:HC-18/58/2021/1176) dated 02.02.2022 on the subject matrix of Selection of Khadim-ul-Hujjaj (KuH) fot Haj- 2022.

Two (2) Days Training Programme for selected Khadim-ul-Hujjaj of Haj-2022 will be conducted on 7th & 8th May, 2022 in the office of Haj Committee of India, Bait-ul-Hujjaj (Haj House), 7-A, M.R.A. Marg (Palton Road), Mumbai-400 001. The registration will start at 8:00 a.m. on 7th May, 2022 and the participants will have to occupy their seats by 09:15 a.m. The training session will be commenced from 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. All KuH have to arrange their return journey only after 08:00 p.m., of 8th May, 2022 as their presence shall be mandatory during all Training session. The final decision in this regard shall be taken as soon as Haj Quota for Haj Committee of India is announced.

The Hon'ble Minister of Minority Affairs will be inaugurating the said programme and Chairman, HCoI will grace the occasion.

Haj Committee of India will provide necessary accommodation to the candidates attending the Training programme. No Travelling Allowance will be admissible. Certificate of participation shall be issued in favour of these KuH only, who will attend all sessions of Training. The certificate(s) will be sent to respective State Haj Committees for further disbursement. This certificate is required to be preserved by the selected Khadim-ul-Hujjaj and produce to the Incharge Haj Camp at their respective Embarkation Point. It is further required to be submitted to the Consulate General of India, Jeddah on arrival in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. It may be ensured that there should be 100% participation of the KuH in the training programme including those in the waiting list of their State.

The Executive Officers of State/U.T. Haj Committee may make it convenient to participate in the aforementioned training programme.
